— Assessment

Each participant will be assessed by his/her participation and performance in the program.

After successful completion of the program, participants will be awarded with 2 Wuhan University academic credits and a certificate.



Tuition & Fees

- ❖ Wuhan University offers scholarships for 2023 Luojia International Summer Program, and the scholarship covers the following:
 - -Registration fee;
 - -Tuition fee;
 - -Housing (on-campus accommodation for the stay in Wuhan, mostly double rooms);
 - -Field trips and cultural activities in Wuhan;
 - -Basic accident insurance for the stay in Wuhan.
- Participant students are required to cover:
 - -Airfare cost;
 - -Meals (estimated 10 US dollars per day for meals offered in student canteen);
 - -Adequate personal medical insurance for stay in China;
 - -Cost for the trip to SuZhou (optional; estimated 600 US dollars covering round CRH tickets, local transportation, hotel accommodation, meals, tickets to scenic spots, travel accident insurance, and English guide service)

Eligibility & How to Apply

— Eligibility

The applicants for the summer program should fulfill the following requirements:

- Foreign nationals currently enrolling with a college or university
- Must be at least 18 but no more than 30 years of age as of June 25, 2023
- Provide proof of English
 proficiency if your first language
 or teaching language in home
 institution is not English (IELTS:
 6.5 or above; or TOFEL: 85 or
 above; or a letter of reference
 from your home institution to
 prove that your English
 proficiency is of a sufficient level
 for learning and communication)



How to Apply

Channel 1

Partner University Nomination

The summer program is open to students from Wuhan University's partner universities worldwide. It's suggested that students consult their home institution regarding the partnership with Wuhan University and submit applications through their home institutions. Wuhan University will accept and review the nominations from its partner universities.

Deadline for nomination: March 31st, 2023

Materialsfornomination from partner universities:

- Nomination list (attached and completed by partner university);
- Application Form (attached);
- Electronic copy of passport personal information page;
- One electronic copy of applicant's passport-format photo;
- Proof of proficiency in English (if applicable).

It's preferable that partner universities collect and send the abovementioned materials in one package to ispteam@whu.edu.cn; and please name the package as "2023+Name of Partner University"; and it's recommended that the materials of each applicant filed and named individually.

Wuhan University has the right to review the nominations and will inform partner universities of the admission decision via email before April $10^{\rm th}$, 2023.

Self-application

The program is also open to individual students from colleges or universities which are not partners of Wuhan University.

Deadline for application: March 31st, 2023

Materials for self-application:

- Application Form (attached);
- · Curriculum Vitae;
- Official academic transcript;
- Electronic copy of passport personal information page;
- One electronic copy of applicant's passport-format photo;
- · Proof of proficiency in English (if applicable).

Applicants are required to send the above-mentioned materials in one package to ispteam@whu.edu.cn, and it's recommended that the package is named as "2023+Name".

Wuhan University will review the application materials and inform the applicant of admission decision before April 10th, 2023.

Remarks: An on-line registration linkage will be provided to each admitted student for registration with the program, which shall be completed by April 20th, 2023.
